The recipient of the award will be selected based on her/his innovative research contributions in an emerging area of applied or industrial mathematics. Eligible nominees should hold a permanent position within Canada or be a CAIMS•SCMAI member of at least four years standing. Nominations should reach:

no later than **January 30, 2004** and should include four copies of each of: a title for the nomination designating research contributions in a specific area; a summary of the contributions in the form of a five-line press release; a detailed description (no longer than two pages) of the research contributions of the nominee in the specified area; a CV including the list of publications; and four reprints. A prize of \$1,000 and a commemorative plaque will be presented to the recipient at the CAIMS•SCMAI Annual Meeting.

The recipient will be invited to give a plenary lecture at the CAIMS•SCMAI Annual Meeting in the year of the award. CAIMS•SCMAI will provide a travel allowance of \$500.
